AN HISTORICAL REPLICA DINGBOT-BY PROF. KAJA FOGLIO OUN DINGBOT-BY

Ta-dah! It's a cute little replica dingbot! (Slightly flatter than the originals.)

Body, feet, hands and an antenna are all provided, plus lots of in-between bits to connect them.

Originally, these were printed on inside back and back cover of the Girl Genius comic. That way, when you cut them out, you got two-sided pieces. For home printing purposes, the front and back pieces are numbered so that you know which pieces to glue back to back. If you do this, you'll still get a two-sided dingbot. Do this step before you attach the arms and legs to the body.

Once the pieces are cut out, punch holes in the indicated spots. Put it all together in an arrangement of your own choosing. Metal brads work great for this, as do small rivets. Tape or glue will work in a pinch, if you don't require articulation. Please note that there is no marked spot for the antenna? Just stick it on anywhere you like. Or not.
